- •Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) is the advanced stage of HIV.

The Numbers

- 33,000 AIDS diagnoses in 2010. 47,000 HIV diagnoses in 2010.
- 1.2 million Americans have HIV.
- 1/5 of them don't know.



Did you know?

- HIV can be contracted through the sharing of bodily fluids (blood, semen, breast milk).
- HIV cannot be contracted from shaking hands, hugging, toilet seats, or eating utensils.
